Both these claims are absolutely untrue. We have entered no new labor agreements with the 707 in Chicago which would impact the MFN agreement. Joe asked for a .25 increase for the Chi Amtrack drivers he organized but we declined to agree because of MFN impact. The 707 organized two new sites in WI (Fun Du Lac and Stevens Point) for which we agreed on a nominal wage increase and agreed for the locations to go into the 707 Master Agreement. That is it. Nothing to send you. Thx
